Dear Support Person,

The Sex Offender Treatment and Monitoring Program (SOTMP) at the Colorado Department of Corrections is presenting an introductory education meeting for families, friends and others who are considering supporting someone who has committed a sexual offense in an effort to prevent re-offending. If you are considering or have already decided to support someone, this meeting will help you learn about sex offense specific treatment. Our goal is to help you acquire the knowledge and skills you will need to become an effective component of this person's relapse prevention plan and community supervision team in order to prevent further sexual offending behavior. This will include learning how to: support the person's change efforts; reinforce the person's participation in treatment; support treatment and supervision rules and requirements; develop a cooperative working relationship with the SOTMP and Parole; identify tactics of manipulation and criminal thinking errors and hold the person accountable.
