Gateway Program

The goal of the Gateway Program is to reduce recidivism and provide positive outcomes for individuals involved with the criminal justice system. This is a program specifically designed to assist ex-offenders in reconnecting with their career, community, and family. It addresses professional, educational, and social goals in an innovative and structured academic environment.

Prospective students are referred to Red Rocks Community College by their probation office, parole office, GED instructor, or case manager. Students are required to attend an orientation designed to introduce them to their academic environment, assist them in applying for financial aid, and familiarize them with the expectations required of college students.

An Education Coordinator works with highly qualified instructors and tutors to provide academic advising, technical assistance, supportive services, and career planning in both classroom and individual settings.

Gateway Courses

Academic Achievement Strategies :: 3 credits :: Develops personalized approaches to learn and succeed for easier transition into college.

Career Development :: 3 credits :: This class assists students in making realistic decisions concerning educational and occupational objectives.

Sociology of Family Dynamics :: 3 credits :: Explores the stability and diversity of the family and examines how social, cultural and personal factors influence family relations.

Credit

What is Credit?

A Credit score is a statistical analysis of an individuals borrowing and repaying used to inform a prospective lender of financial history.

Why is your credit score Important?

A credit score is used by any lender to establish if you are a favorable candidate for a loan, job or housing. A credit score is what the lender uses to determine the loan's interest rate, their risk in loaning to you and if your past will disqualify your request.

What are the three major Credit Bureaus?

Most lenders trust three companies to provide statistical data regarding your financial history.

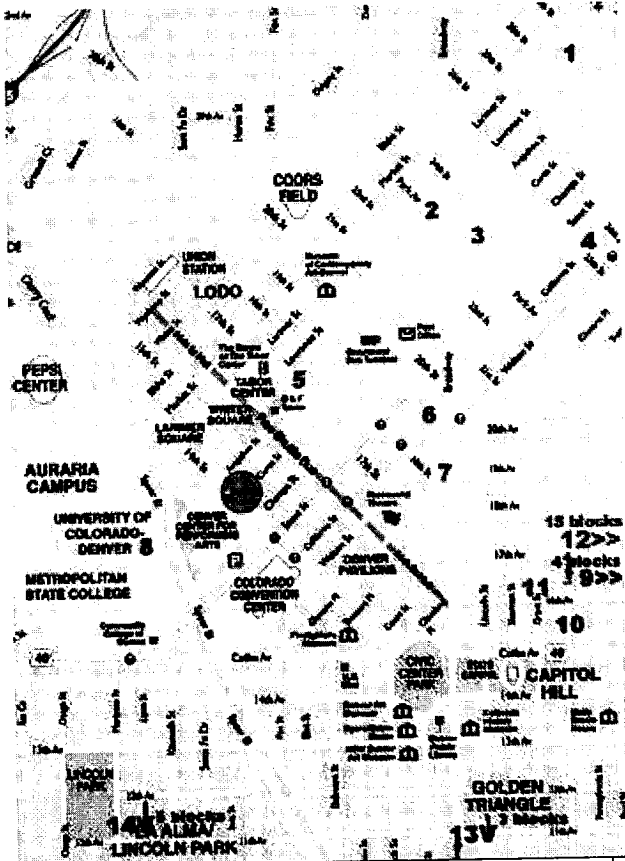
